

The Jewell City Council met in a Regular Session June 10, 2019, at the Jewell City Hall starting at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Walker called the meeting to order with Council Members: Outzen, Reiter, Lorenzen and Winborn present. Absent – Roethler.

**APPROVE MINUTES OF MAY 29, 2019, REGULAR SESSION:**

Winborn made a motion to approve the minutes of May 29, 2019, Regular Session. Reiter seconded the motion. Roll Call 4 – 0. Motion carried.

**PUBLIC INPUT:** a) Dave Nobiling was present to ask that recycling be picked up every week instead of twice a month. The City Council will invite a Trash Man representative to a future council meeting to discuss the options. b) Dick Barkema stated his concerns about the new streets being put in with no curb or gutter. Mayor Walker explained that this is a cost saving measure. c) Chris Gunderson asked when East Lane Street will be replaced. There are no plans at this time to replace East Lane Street.

**NUISANCE ABATEMENT ISSUES:** Several Jewell residents were present to express their concerns about yards not being mowed, junk vehicles, building projects not completed and properties that are not being maintained. Mayor Walker informed them that the Police Board had just met on Wednesday, June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and discussed the same issues.

**PARK/BASEBALL FIELD LIGHT PROJECT:** No additional information was available at this time. No action was taken.

**CITY SHED HEATER QUOTE:** Winborn made a motion to approve Innovative Ag Services quote of \$3,924.00 to replace a heater at the City Shed. Outzen seconded the motion. Roll Call 4 – 0. Motion carried.

**POOL:** Reiter made a motion to approve a free swim day at the Jewell Pool on Saturday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 as part of the Jewell Jubilee Celebration. Outzen seconded the motion. Roll Call 4 – 0. Motion carried.

**PARKING PORTION OF BUSINESS MAIN STREET:** Reiter made a motion to approve Manatt's quote of \$47,120.00 to replace the parking portion of the two blocks of business Main Street with asphalt. Winborn seconded the motion. Roll Call 4 – 0. Motion carried.

**RESIDENTIAL POOL ORDINANCE:** The City Council reviewed several examples of a residential pool ordinance. With the increasing number of pools in town with no security fence, safety is becoming a major concern. Reiter made a motion to table the discussion until the next city council meeting. Winborn seconded the motion. Roll Call 4 – 0. Motion carried.

**HEARTLAND MARKET CIGARETTE PERMIT:** The City of Jewell has not received the required application. No action was taken at this time.

**W&G MARKETING:** The City Council, Public Works Department, Police Department and Fire Department were invited to facility tour and meal at W&G Marketing.

**ADJOURN:** Reiter made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Outzen seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 9:09 p.m.
