PUBLIC HEARING: *Gunderson made a motion to open the Public hearing at 7:15 p.m. confirming the sale of Lot 8. Roethler seconded the motion. Roll call 5 – 0. Motion carried. Public hearing proceeded, reviewing the offer for the purchase of Lot 8. Boor made a motion to close the public hearing. Gunderson seconded. Roll call 5 – 0. Motion carried.*

LOT #8/RESOLUTION 22-21: *Winborn made a motion to approve resolution 22-21 authorizing the sale of Lot 8. Roethler seconded the motion. Roll Call 5 – 0. Motion carried.*

CLOSE KING STREET FOR VENDORS: *The possibility was discussed that King Street could be closed to accommodate vendors for city wide events such as Junk Jaunt. The proposition will be discussed further at the July 11 meeting.*

PROPOSAL TO UPGRADE COMPUTERS: *A proposal was made to upgrade computers at City Hall and the EJS Police Department. Proposal will be discussed at a later date.*
