

The Jewell City Council met in Special Session Monday, April 17, 2023 at the Jewell City Hall starting at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Reiter called the meeting to order with Council Members: Roethler, Boor, Gunderson, Winborn and Lorenzen present.

APPROVE APRIL 17, 2023, AGENDA: Gunderson made a motion to approve the April 17 agenda. Roethler seconded the motion. Roll Call 5—0. Motion carried.

MAIN STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT: The Main Street Improvement project consists of putting in new watermains from Edwards St. to the Union Pacific Railroad, sidewalks and upgraded street lighting. Many aspects of the sidewalk project were discussed by the Council and members of the community. Decorative lighting and other visually aesthetic features were considered. Issues such as funding, public parking and businesses being able to remain open were also discussed. Gabe Nelson, from Snyder and Associates, will be at the April 24th regular council meeting to field questions and give his recommendation on the best course of action.
