

The Jewell City Council met in Regular Session Monday, June 26, 2023 at the Jewell City Hall starting at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Leo Reiter called the meeting to order with Council Members: Gunderson, Boor, Winborn and Lorenzen present. Council member Roethler was absent.

APPROVE JUNE 26, 2023, AGENDA: Winborn made a motion to approve the June 26 agenda. Lorenzen seconded the motion. Roll Call 4—0. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION 23-12: Lorenzen made a motion to approve Resolution 23-12, a resolution approving the 2nd amendment for fiscal year 2022-2023. Boor seconded the motion. Roll Call 4—0. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION 23-13: Winborn made a motion to approve Resolution 23-13, adopting a Credit Card Policy for the City of Jewell. Lorenzen seconded the motion. Roll Call 4—0. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION 23-14: Winborn made a motion to approve Resolution 23-14, adopting a Purchasing Policy for the City of Jewell. Gunderson seconded the motion. Roll Call 4—0. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION 23-15: Boor made a motion to approve Resolution 23-15, a wage resolution for the City of Jewell's new Public Works Director, Terry Anderson. Anderson will have an annual salary of \$60,000, with five possible \$1,000 raises for certificates. The City will pay for classes required to complete duties and will pay Anderson while attending classes. Homework must be done on his own time. The City will require schooling to be completed within a three-year time frame. Anderson must commit to remaining employed by the City for five years, or he will be required to pay back a prorated amount of the schooling he has received. Lorenzen seconded the motion. Roll Call 4—0. Motion Carried
