OLSON WATER METER: 101 Anderson Street had a new water meter installed, previous meter was called into question. Winborn made a motion to credit the water account 3 months of sewer in the amount of \$64.79. Roethler seconded the motion. Roll Call 4—0. Motion carried.

RECYCLING BIDS: The Trashman and American Sanitation both gave sealed bids for a five-year recycling contract with the City beginning September 1, 2023 and ending September 1, 2028. The Trashman had 3 options: a) 18-gallon bin, weekly pick-up, cost \$4/household, b) 64-gallon EZ cart, weekly pick-up, \$4.78/household, c) 64-gallon EZ cart, bi-weekly pick-up, \$4/household. American Sanitation's bid allows residents to pick from any of their 3 sizes, 35-gallon, 64 gallon and 96-gallon, weekly pick-up, \$4/household

and a promise of no fuel surcharges for the duration of the contract. Gunderson made a motion to accept the bid from American Sanitation. Roethler seconded the motion. Roll Call 4—0. Motion carried.

WATER TOWER: Jake Dugger from Maguire Iron gave a presentation on maintenance plan options for the city water tower. After reviewing the options Winborn made a motion to approve a full maintenance plan contract, which would include re-painting every 12-15 years and power washes in between paintings as well as inspections and maintenance on the tower itself, pending our city attorney, Justin Deppe, approves the contract as well. The cost of the contract would be \$5,000 for the next two years, \$68,363 for the following four years (to do an initial painting), then \$21,372 each subsequent year, with a potential 5% increase. Gunderson seconded the motion. Roll Call 4—0. Motion carried.
