

The Jewell City Council met in special session Monday March 23, 2026 at the Jewell City Hall starting at 7:00p.m. Mayor Mickey Walker called the meeting to order with Council members: Joe Joslin, Aaron Boor, Stacy Alsager, Steve Butler, and Karl Corbin present.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** Alsager made a motion to approve the March 23, 2026 special agenda. Joslin seconded the motion. Roll Call 5—0. Motion carried.

***PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE 2026-2027 PROPERTY TAX PORTION OF THE BUDGET:***

Mayor Walker opened the public hearing at 7:00 p.m. The property taxes were reviewed. The city will levy \$410,539 in consolidated general funds, \$111,060 in liability, property and self-insurance, \$51,811 for FICA and IPERS, \$91,329 in other employee benefits, \$85,112 for debt service, and \$7,436 in ag land. There were two questions or concerns from residents, both were displeased with how high property taxes had become from the city, county and school. Boor made a motion to close the public hearing. Corbin seconded the motion. Roll Call 5—0. Motion carried.

**ADJOURN:** Joslin made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Alsager seconded the motion. Roll Call 5—0. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:18 p.m.
