In visiting with Steve from Electronic Engineering it appears that no other agency has come to them with the same problem we are having. He believes it is the proximity to a tower that is the difference as WC does not have issue in their schools. Steve believed the best option and most reasonably priced option is to use the WIFI network within the school and purchase the radio that is compatible with that. Quote for that radio was reviewed. The price for the WIFI programming and program is about \$200 per radio with a \$100 per radio annual fee.
